Feedstock Codes

The Blackbridge Biomass to Energy Facility (BtEf) will utilise 50% virgin biomass and 50% recovered biomass as feedstock.

The codes in the table below will be applied for in the Environmental Permit Application to NRW and represent the 50% of feedstock that will come from recovered biomass. The codes have been taken from the governments document "Guidance on the Classification and assessment of waste, 1st Edition 2015".

Materials selected from the list below will be pre - treated off site prior to delivery to comply with the feedstock specification of 20mm maximum particle size and maximum 20% moisture content.
