I refer to your email of 2nd March 2018 with attached correspondence to Louise Edwards of NRW.

I note that you have provided comment on those prospective planning conditions that were included in NRW correspondence dated 20th October 2017 (their Appendix D). You have not considered the prospective planning conditions previously provided by PCC (and which are also referred to in the NRW correspondence). Nevertheless, I trust you will agree that a single set of prospective ecological conditions would be beneficial. PCC and NRW therefore intend to agree a single set of ecological conditions once the "supplementary environmental information and HRA" has been considered - at the time of the publicity period required of the EIA Regulations (as referred to in PINS letter dated 24th January 2018).

With regard to your "position statement" of 2nd March 2018 under heading "PCC Comments in letter dated 20th October 2017", I welcome your confirmation that matters will be addressed and included in the submission to PINS. I have liaised further with the Council's Ecologist and have appended some informal comments for you to consider when preparing your submission. I shall defer to NRW in respect of those matters under heading "NRW Proposed Conditions".
